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1. Child Protection

Identification and referral of at-risk children; prevention of abuse, neglect, and exploitation; provision of child-friendly case management and protection services.

2. Psychosocial Support (PSS)

Group and individual-based psychosocial support activities that help children develop emotional regulation, resilience, and coping strategies, especially in crisis contexts.

3. Child Participation

Ensuring children's active involvement in decision-making processes through safe and inclusive platforms such as children's clubs, councils, and creative expression workshops.

4. Access to Education & Safe Learning Environments

Support programs for children facing barriers to education; promotion of trauma-sensitive school environments; capacity-building for teachers and school staff.

5. Community-Based Child Protection

Strengthening protective mechanisms within communities through awareness-raising, capacity-building, and local child protection structures involving families and local actors.

6. Emergency Child Protection

Rapid response to protect children in emergencies such as natural disasters, displacement, or conflict; establishment of safe spaces and provision of psychological first aid.
